## Principal's Message

Welcome to the start of what promises to be the best school year yet for you and your family at Rivers Edge!! The teachers, staff, and I are thrilled to kick-off the 2011-2012 School Year where we are celebrating being "High 5 Heroes!" A special thank you to the efforts of the teachers, staff, and many parent volunteers who have worked hard, often behind the scenes, to prepare for this new school year.

We started the summer by welcoming a new Associate Principal, Mrs. Melissa R. Halquist-Pruden, to The Edge. (The title for Assistant Principal has been changed to Associate Principal as part of the succession program in Henrico County Public Schools to train and prepare leaders to be ready to take on the role of principal when there are openings across our school district.) This year, our Associate Principal position is split between Short Pump Elementary and Rivers Edge. However, right before school started, we learned that Mrs. Pruden was being appointed as the new principal at Glen Allen Elementary School. We are proud of her new advancement and wish her all the best! The process for finding a replacement Associate Principal will begin shortly and will more than likely be a joint effort between Short Pump Elementary and Rivers Edge. Once the position is filled, the plan is for the Associate Principal to be at Rivers Edge on Monday mornings (7:20-11:15 a.m.) and all day Thursdays and Fridays.

Our theme this year, "High 5 Heroes" celebrates and focuses on creating a school climate that encourages respect for everyone. We will be encouraging our students to be a H.E.R.O. (**H**elping **E**veryone **R**espect **O**thers). We will also celebrate and reward students for five main characteristics: 1) Being kind to others; 2) Respecting others; 3) Helping others; 4) Including others; and 5) Encouraging others. We look forward to having a kick-off

assembly to help students understand the focus and expectation of respect through an assembly on Thursday, September 8. Grades K-1 will have their celebration from 8:30 – 9:15 a.m., and grades 2-5 will have their celebration from 9:30 – 10:15 a.m. Everyone is welcomed to come join the fun and see our Eagle "Super Hero" Mascot, "REES."

We were pleased to get the results of our 2011 SOL tests. Our overall SOL Pass Rates for 2011 are:

**English = 96.24% pass**

**Math = 97.06% pass**

**SS = 97.84% pass**

**Sci = 98.67% pass**

A reminder that the Dress Code can be found in the Student Code of Conduct booklet. The main guidelines to remember are: 1) All skirts, dresses, shorts, etc. cannot be higher than 4 inches above the knee; 2) Shoulder straps must be at least 2-inches wide; and 3) No flip flops or high heels. If your child's clothing does not meet the guidelines, you will be contacted to let you know that your child needs to wear a different outfit. If a student continues to dress in ways that do not follow the dress code, the administration will get involved and you will be asked to bring a change of clothing for your student.

Looking forward to seeing everyone at Back-to-School Night on Thursday, September 22 at 6:30 p.m. I encourage you to join the PTA, as the membership provides great support to the school, your child, and our continuous improvement. Excitement is in the air and you can feel the spirit and passion needed for a "Super Hero" year!
